



FIRST NATIONAL BANK BOND COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND APPLICATION HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE

APPLICATION DEADLINE April 2, 2018 | 3:00 p.m.

Eligibility

To be eligible to compete for a First National Bank scholarship, an applicant:

- Must graduate from Greenville High School or Mulberry Grove High School during the Spring of 2018;
- Must submit a complete application and a one page essay on a topic supplied by The First National Bank prior to the deadline;
- Must submit an official copy of high school transcript;
- Must meet academic requirements for admission to a college, university, or technical school;
- Must be attending an accredited college or technical school as a fulltime student in Fall 2018;
- Must maintain a 2.5 grade average at said college or technical school to receive funding for Spring of 2019.

Criteria

- Please note the following when completing the application:
 - ❖ Complete and submit application by deadline;
 - ❖ Must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average to apply;
 - ❖ Must have exhibited the willingness to “go the extra mile” in academics, sports, or other extra-curricular activities.
- FNB directors, employees, and their immediate families are not eligible to apply.
- All decisions of the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final.
- Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded at each school.
- The scholarship award will be sent directly to the financial aid department of the recipient’s chosen college or technical school. Half of the award will be payable in the Fall of 2018 with the balance paid in the Spring of 2019.
- Scholarship winner must provide an official copy of mid-year transcript.
