



BRETT SCHEWE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA AND APPLICATION HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE

APPLICATION DEADLINE March 1 3:00 p.m.

Eligibility

To be eligible to compete for the Brett Schewe Memorial scholarship, an applicant:

1. Must graduate from Mulberry Grove High School during the Spring semester;
2. Must submit to the MGHS Guidance Office a complete application and a two page essay on a topic supplied prior to the deadline;
3. Must submit an official copy of high school transcript;
4. Must meet academic requirements for admission to a college, university, or technical school;
5. Must be attending an accredited college or technical school as a full-time student in Fall semester;
6. Must maintain a 2.5 grade average at said college or technical school to receive funding for the following Spring semester.

Criteria

Please note the following when completing the application:

1. Complete and submit application by deadline;
 2. Must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average to apply;
 3. Must have strong involvement in FFA activities at time of application.
- FNB directors, employees, and their immediate families are not eligible to apply.
 - All decisions of the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final.
 - One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.
 - The scholarship award will be sent directly to the financial aid department of the recipient's chosen college or technical school. Half of the award will be payable in the Fall semester with the balance paid in the following Spring semester.
 - Scholarship winner must provide an official copy of mid-year transcript.
