## **Requirements**

The Payge Donaldson Scholarship is a non-renewable award that will be paid directly to the college, university, or trade school attended by the student. This monetary gift will be awarded annually at the Ramsey High School awards day or graduation ceremony and is contingent upon the amount in the fund account. In order to be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior at Ramsey High School.
- Possess and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Provide an official high school transcript with this application.
- Intend to pursue a career in the medical field or working with children.
- Be enrolled in a college, university or technical school.
- Demonstrate characteristics of being caring, kind-hearted, giving back to the community and family oriented.
- Preference may be given to those students with a demonstrated financial need.
- Must furnish copies of your parents' Federal Tax Return that shows the Adjusted Gross Income for the current year.
- Completed application, official transcript, Federal Tax Return, and personal essay submitted by **April 1<sup>st</sup>** in the same envelope to the school office or dropped off/mailed to:
